

Rob Ryerson Residential Soccer Camp Information Sheet

Registration:

Once you arrive on the first day of your registered camp, signs will be posted on the campus and staff will be visible to assist you to the registration area. All campers must check in at registration to receive housing assignments and room keys. Registration is between 2:30-4:00 p.m. Goalkeeping check-in is between 12pm-12:45pm. All roommate requests placed on the camp registration will be honored at this time. Please call if you have any further requests or questions regarding the housing assignments. **All late arrivals must contact Rob Ryerson prior to the start of camp to make prior arrangements.**

Orientation:

Following registration, we will have a welcoming session to talk about the week and introduce staff members. The welcome session is optional for parents, but Camper attendance is mandatory. Please see details at registration.

Security & Medical:

Campus Police will monitor the camp program 24 hours a day. A modern hospital is located nearby, and a physician is on call 24 hours a day. Camp athletic trainers will be on duty during all activities, and remain on the campsite full-time. Please complete the medical history form so we can learn further about any illness or injury that restricts normal athletic activity, or if your child is on medication or under treatment. All parents will be notified immediately should your son or daughter become ill or be injured.

What to Bring:

- **All campers must provide bed linens, pillows and bath towels**
- Please bring a soccer ball. (Soccer balls purchased thru camp will be distributed prior to the first training session)
- One-week supply of soccer attire including rain gear
- Outdoor soccer shoes, shingaurds, water bottle and sun-screen
- Casual attire and a bathing suit along with comfortable sneakers in case we have to play indoors

Suggested Items: alarm clock, soap, toothbrush and toothpaste

Camp Store and Key Deposit:

At check in, a refundable \$20.00 key deposit (checks or cash) is required to be paid at the camp store along with any monies to be used at the store to purchase items throughout the week. The camp store provides snacks, drinks, and limited soccer equipment if campers desire. Camp store hours will be posted during camp. Upon departure, any unused monies along with the key deposit (given the key is returned) will be returned at check-out.

Camp Activities:

All participants will be able to enjoy the many activities including, pool tables, ping- pong, wide screen TV's, video conference rooms and an Olympic size swimming pool. **Certified lifeguards are on duty during pool hours.**

Team/Group assignments:

All participants will be assigned to specific teams with their own staff coach. The teams will be formed based on age. Campers that have come in groups or teams will be placed together. These assignments can be adjusted if necessary.

Departure:

The camp will conclude after morning matches and the awards ceremony. The awards ceremony will begin promptly at 12:00noon on the last day of your registered camp. There will be no lunch provided on the last day. All campers will be available to depart after the awards ceremony. For any early departures, Rob Ryerson must be notified in advance.

Camp Schedules: Will be posted in the campus dormitories during your respective week at camp.

Refund Policy: There will be NO refunds for cancellations after 21 days prior to your scheduled camp.
